LETS Bus Information. The LETS bus will be in Putnam 5 days a week at a cost of \$22,000/ year, we would incur 1/3 costs to have it available on an on-call basis to take our residents shopping, dr. appointments, or to the senior center in Putnam. This service is not restricted to just seniors. **Motion** Walker support Cowan to support our share of the cost of \$7,300 for 1 year on a trial basis. Carried.
