Planning Report: Topping reports a public hearing is scheduled for October 26<sup>th</sup> to review "Commercial" solar operations ordinance.

Public Safety Reports: Police Chief Russell written report received.

Fire Chief Huse thanked the PD for their help with an accident scene, based on that accident they are looking to purchase new reflective vests at a cost of approx. \$1000.00, also looking to purchase warranty on Rescue Randy and moveable stairs for Fire Station. Backup camera installation almost complete on vehicles. They are looking to replace a 1995 engine truck. They hope to have a Fire Department open house type day in the park on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, dependent on weather. Working on roof leak from bell tower, gutter issue.

Recreation Report: working on paving 1 mile of trail with grant money, searching for company that can bid, may not happen till next year. Survey is done for recreation plan. Need to look at repairing solar lights at both Unadilla Park and trailhead. They will set a date for a public hearing for Recreation Plan in near future.

Correspondence: Audits complete went well. Parking blocks were offered to the township, chief Russell to notify them we can't use them at this time.

Unfinished Business: Wheelie Bins business being notified by attorney to cease operations.

New Business: Sgt. Gelman gave a very informative presentation on the tornado sirens and the process to replace. She is working with county and fire department to replace ours and possible install others.

Motion Walker second Weiland to replace the siren at the Fire Hall. All in favor.
