

Unadilla Township Regular Meeting Minutes  
October 13, 2022

Meeting called to order at 7:01 p.m.

Pledge to flag.

Present: Walker, Topping, Weiland, Cowan, Cox. Absent: None

Motion Walker support Cox to approve the agenda. Carried.

Motion Walker support Cowan to approve September 2022 minutes as amended. Carried.

Call to Public: Frank Sample running for County Commissioner was present to introduce himself.

Show Cause Hearings: Southwell (E. Trebesh) owners son present requested we give him 30 days to get renter to clean up property. Consensus agreed.

Wilson (Kaiser and Hadley) owner present requested we give him time, owner agreed to get proper paperwork filed at county by next meeting and we will review at that time. Consensus agreed.

Powers (W. Trebesh) owner present requested 30 days to get permits to place mobile home and clean up property. Consensus agreed.

Singman (VanSyckle) owners present requested we give her until our January meeting to get things cleaned up, in process of moving to N. Carolina with animals as Consumers has to remove their barn for new pipeline. Consensus agreed.

Reports: Planning met working on kennel license procedure since County has changed theirs.

Police Report: Chief Russell requests we purchase external vest carriers for officers, he will do this as they are being replaced. Motion Weiland support Cox to approve purchases as needed, approximate cost this year \$4,000.00. Carried. Batteries are needed to replace outdated for the AED's. Motion Walker support Cowan to purchase. Carried.

Fire Report: Chief Hause reports they are holding fire prevention day from 10 to 1 this Saturday. Consumers donated a home on Orlando to use as training.

Recreation Report: Cowan requests we purchase a picnic table and or bench for the playground area. She also reports new swings and chains are on order for the playground. New Playscape is up and being used.

Unfinished Business: Broadband update, Surf Air was originally going to only be able to do 135 homes and have increased that to 275 homes with same cost. Mr. Bates is going to bring contract to sign this coming week.

Trail Update: currently closed for 2 weeks to pave 1 mile from Gregory to VanSyckle.

New Business: Motion Walker support Cox to approve contract with Boyce heating to fix the heating cooling system and bring to code. Carried.

Motion Topping support Walker to put the 1% admin fee into a separate fund towards internet for the township rather than just in general fund. Carried.

Final Call to Public: Board consensus to set trick or treat hours from 5 to 7 p.m. in Gregory.

Walker introduced Steve Richmond who will be acting as our board liaison for the Road Commission. Chief Hause reports that they are having issues with the clean up policy for cemetery in Stockbridge with when the flags should be removed. She states they look nice up and they are replacing tattered flags but plan to leave up from Memorial Day to Labor Day.
