Motion Walker, second Cox to approve October 14, 2021 meeting minutes. Carried.

Motion Walker, second Weiland to approve payment of bills as presented. Carried.

Motion Walker second Cowan to approve moving \$250,000.00 from General Fund to MSUFCU checking. All in favor, Carried.

Motion Walker second Cox to approve signers to all accounts as Treasurer Julie Weiland, Clerk Linda Topping, and Deputy Clerk Patricia Dunn. All in favor, Carried.

Call to Public: County Commissioner Doug Helzerman was present with an update on county issues and discussed broadband survey.

Planning Commission report by Topping, they held public hearing on commercial solar ordinance with no public comment. **Motion** Topping, second Walker to approve the commercial solar ordinance as presented. Carried.

Public Safety Reports: Sgt. Gelman presented an update on tornado sirens, costs etc. After some questions, Sgt. Gelman will report back with new maps. Sgt. Gelman also requests we approve a resolution to approve her seeking grant money to pay for new tasers; as ours are outdated and no longer supported. **Motion** Topping second Cox to approve resolution and purchase of new tasers. 
Correspondence: Broadband survey available on Livingston County website along with a link on our website and we will distribute information in tax bills.
