Pledge to flag.

Present: Walker, Topping, Weiland, Cox. Absent: Cowan.

Motion Walker support Cox to approve agenda. Carried.

Motion Walker support Cox to approve March 28, 2024 minutes. Carried.

Motion Walker support Topping to pay bills as presented. Carried.

Call to Public: Dan Wholihan was present to introduce himself and to announce his wife Kristina Lyke is running for State Representative, with a platform of returning local control on issues.

Unfinished Business:

Show Cause (Wynn, 20449 Barton) no show, consensus send to attorney.

Planning Report: Meeting scheduled for April 23, 2024.

Police Report by Chief Russell. Still seeking part time and full-time officers. Several items to discuss, requesting manning holiday coverage, chief to get us a history of holiday calls.

Police needs records help to clear out old files, but must be gone through carefully and trained specific to lien. **Motion** Cox support Weiland to a-lot \$5,000 towards clean out. Carried. Chief requested Investigator laptop, can't be connected to the server for various discreet reasons.

Motion Topping, support Walker to purchase laptop approx. cost \$1,500. Carried.

Chief requested part-time officers receive some CTO should not exceed \$1,000 per year.

Motion Cox support Weiland to approve CTO. Carried.

Chief requested new switch in computer closet. Current switch full and not serviceable cost approximately \$879, **Motion** Weiland support Walker to approve new switch. Carried.

Chief requested technology closet refurbishment. The closet houses internet and phone related equipment, it's extremely crowded cords everywhere, needs some removed and rewired so that it can be serviceable and reliable. **Motion** Weiland support Weiland to approve cost of approx. \$2,682. Carried.

Chief requested new workstation for part-time officers, current computer more than 10 years old with outdated operating system, cost approx. \$1,100. **Motion** Weiland support Cox to approve purchase. Opposed Walker, **Motion** Carried.

Chief requested new mobile data computer in car, also a decade old with outdated systems, he would like to start replacing one every year for the 4 cars to keep up to date. Cost for computer and docking station approx. \$2,600. **Motion** Weiland support Walker. Carried.

Fire Report by Chief Hause, with warm weather people are out burning need to be careful of field fires. Officers Beutler and Smith are in SD, looking at new truck purchase. Chief Hause thanked Amber Smith for helping take pictures of officers for website.

Correspondence: Wave Bus in conjunction with Lets Bus may be servicing our area.

Unfinished Business: Southwell on Trebesh received an extension of 90 days to get cleanup done. Wilson ongoing, zoning to contact. Powers on Trebesh; no updates. Curvin on Winifred made progress but now backsliding. Hamlin on Dexter Trail given 30 days then it will go to attorney.
